#### **Highlights from August Session Meeting**

The Session continued our discernment process through an exercise where we drew and discussed what each of us saw as the heart of our ministry at Westminster. Key themes that emerged were Christ-centered, community, justice, and outreach/ service.

Three of the task force teams gave short reports. They were housing development, rentals and partnerships. The teams continue to work and can use Session guidance on timing and deliverables. The September Session retreat will help everyone as we move forward.

The Session heard from a small ad-hoc committee which is starting to plan for a fall celebration of our 75th year of ministry. Plans include: a fall celebration for our neighborhood and community, coordinating with the "Raking in the Fun" event, a "history museum" with pictures and items of note from our history, a celebratory worship and luncheon afterwards. All these ideas were met with excitement and affirmation. The team is looking for more volunteers to help with each of these events.

#### **Prayers for Our Community:**

While our in-person prayer group will be taking a break during the summer months, we encourage you to continue to pray for our community throughout the summer. Paul encourages us to "pray without ceasing," so no matter how you pray, just pray!!

There are many creative ways to do this! Here are some to try:

<u>Pray through the Church Directory</u>: Each week, choose a few names from the church directory to pray for. If you don't know them personally, pray that you might meet in the coming months!

<u>Pray through our ongoing prayer list</u>: Go through the names listed below and pray for each person listed there. Perhaps using a simple prayer such as, "Holy God, bring peace and comfort to (name) that they might know your love."

<u>Pray in Color</u>: Take some time to doodle the names of some of the folks you know from church - what do you think they might be praying for? What do you think they might need from God right now? <u>Check out this link</u> for some ideas of how!

<u>Pray the Psalms</u>: Read through some of your favorite Psalms and imagine those words as prayers for the lost, forsaken, or lonely. Psalms of Lament can be powerful prayers in response to some of the challenges we have been facing these days.

<u>Ask others to tell you how to pray</u>. Take some time this week to call a couple church friends or friends you haven't seen in awhile, ask them: How can I be praying for you today?

<u>Pray through the newspaper</u>: However you get your news, take a moment to pray for a specific person or story that captures your attention. How might God bring peace, restoration, grace to that event or person?

\*Throughout the summer, specific prayer concerns will be shared within our Sunday worship services. We encourage folks to share prayers in worship either online or in-person.
