The Greater Hartford Interfaith Action Alliance is in the process of discovering where to focus our next issue slate. We do this by gathering stories from each of the GHIAA member congregations - listening to the

struggles we are facing, noticing where we have common ground, and pulling together to work towards tangible change to make a more just and equitable Hartford and Connecticut.

You have a story to tell. Each of us has struggles that keep us up at night: worries about family members who are struggling with addiction or mental illness, anxiety about medical bills or house payments, concern about the rising costs of higher education, apprehension about the support your family member isn't getting in an institution that should be serving them better... These are the stories that GHIAA needs to hear. These are the stories that will direct our action in the coming years.

GHIAA collects these stories through house meetings - small groups where we can share our stories and hear the stories of our community. And THIS year, we are doing something different: we are joining other GHIAA congregations to share stories and build relationships between GHIAA congregations. We need you to be a part of this story collecting.

Westminster is joining forces for a first-ever cross-congregational house meeting campaign. On April 14 at 4 pm, Westminster will join Congregation Beth Israel and First Church, West Hartford for a gathering of house meetings. All three congregations will gather at First Church (12 S. Main Street, West Hartford) and split into smaller groups to share and hear stories about what keeps them up at night. This is an opportunity for us to meet and know our neighbors in West Hartford, to hear what other West Hartford residents are contending with, and to share our own stories with them. This is an opportunity for us to build our collective power in West Hartford, so that together we might build a future with hope.
