



Advent Study: "Name of the Messiah" Monday at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom



Join the Rev. Julie Emery for an Advent Study: "Names for the Messiah" on Monday at 6:30 p.m. via Zoom

Christians have claimed from their beginnings that Jesus was the Messiah foretold in the Hebrew Scriptures. What were these expectations, and did Jesus fulfill them?

The prophet Isaiah shared a well-known and beloved oracle that uses four titles to describe the Messiah: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. Our study will look at the ways people understood

these royal titles and how Jesus did or did not fulfill these titles.

Using <u>this study by Walter Bruggeman</u>, and delving into other prophetic sources such as Richard Rohr's new <u>"The Tears of Things,"</u> as well as Dietrich Bonhoeffer's words from the Nazi prison

camp, we will ponder the way these prophetic words and titles speak to our lives even now. **Click here** for the Zoom link.
